Definitions

Family reunification means any form of reunification of family members in which one person has been granted a residence permit in Switzerland and would like to obtain a residence permit for one or more persons in their nuclear family. We apply the broader concept of nuclear family, which may include 'social parenthood' (i.e. without biological ties), people with a special dependency, or certain constellations of siblings.
