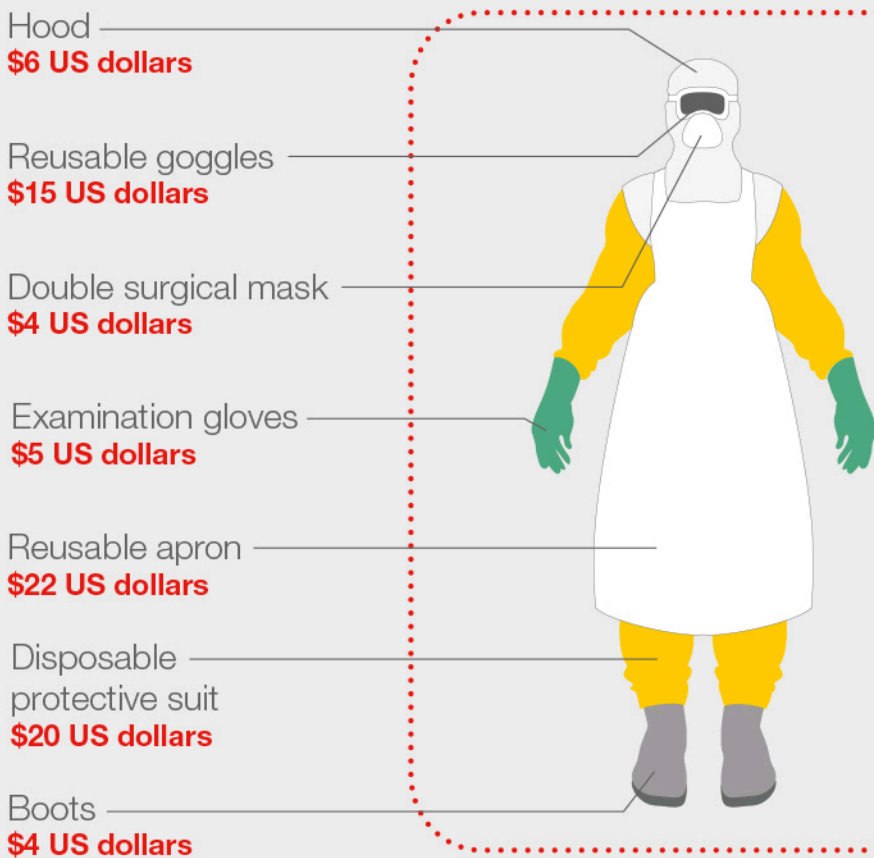

## The cost of Ebola treatment



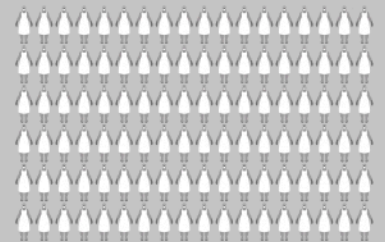
### One complete set

of personal protective equipment (PPE), costs  
**\$76 US dollars.**

Most of the equipment is used just once.

The Red Cross Ebola Treatment Centre in Sierra Leone uses

**150 – 180 sets**  
of PPE **every day**



**That's 5,000+ and \$330,000 US dollars per month.**

A health care worker in the centre will suit up **four times over an 8-hour shift.** While wearing the PPE, they will:



- ⚠ Work a maximum of **1 hour** to reduce the risk of heat stroke
- ⚠ Be exposed to temperatures of up to **47 degree Celsius** (116 degrees Fahrenheit).
- ⚠ Produce up to **3 litres/0.8 gallons** of sweat per hour.

### \$175 US dollars

can supply **one family solidarity kit** containing clothing, food, condoms, bedding, laundry supplies, tableware and water jug.
